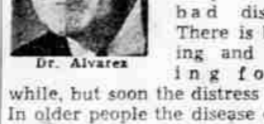

Shingles in Older Persons

Hundreds of oldsters ask me what to do for the terrible pain that has persisted since they had a crop of shingles. I have to answer sadly that I don't know. Shingles in young people is usually not a bad disease. There is burning and itching for a

while, but soon the distress goes. In older people the disease often proves to be a tragedy. It is due, apparently, to the virus of chicken-pox, which severely injures a little ganglion on the sensory half of one of the nerves that runs around the chest next to a rib, and then goes into the spinal chord. With this inflammation there comes a row of blisters in the area of skin supplied by the affected nerve.



In desperation some of the old persons with neuralgia pain have submitted to operations in which the nerve was cut or the affected skin was freed up in such a way as to sever all the nerves under it, but so far as I can learn from the literature these operations have not worked well. The pain keeps coming, apparently not from the scars in the skin, but perhaps from the diseased ganglion in the spinal canal or from damage done to the spinal chord.

There is one drug that sometimes works well and this is called Protamide. Recently, someone has claimed that injections of globulin from the blood

will also help. Many of these old persons have to take large doses of some nerve sedative. Without this they cannot sleep. Dr. Alvarez hopes his readers will understand that it would be impossible for him to answer requests for information or to attempt to diagnose by mail.

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Mrs. FDR Supports Stevenson's Stand

New York (U.P.) - Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt said yesterday continued hydrogen bomb tests might destroy the human race without a war.

Mrs. Roosevelt, at a news conference at her home, declared her support for Adlai Stevenson's call for an end of H-bomb testing by this country, Russia and Britain.

"Nobody knows how much radiation the human race can take," the widow of President Franklin D. Roosevelt said. The United States, she said, is faced with a choice between the great risk of allowing more H-bomb tests and the lesser risk that the Soviet Union would break any test ban agreement.

Navy Men Will Seek Balloon Altitude Mark

Washington (U.P.) - Two Navy men next week will try to go higher in a balloon than man has ever gone before.

The Navy said the balloon is expected to reach an altitude of about 75,000 feet - more than 14 miles.
