Stevenson Charges Campaign of Deceit Waged by Republicans

New York — (AP) — Adlai E. Stevenson finished a two-day tour of New York today angrily charging the Republicans with waging a campaign of deceit unmatched in American politics. Stevenson accused the GOP Wednesday night of spreading "misrepresentations... slush... slogans... epithets... and silly nonsense" in an effort to

stay in power. He said he was "good and mad."

"We haven't tried to deceive the people on the issues—on matters of life and death and of war and peace," the Democratic presidential candidate said.

He is scheduled to leave by plane this afternoon for Springfield, Ill., where he will deliver a major farm speech tonight. He will attend a rally at Rock Island, Ill., Friday, and then fly to the West Coast for California speeches.

In another statement, Stevenson expanded his pledge of support "for responsible action" to help Poland move toward freedom to include Hungary.

Stevenson endorsed economic assistance to a free government in Poland and said the United States should stand ready to bring the Polish situation before the United Nations in a speech in Madison Square Garden Tuesday night.

He has not yet replied to President Eisenhower's "white papers" on the hydrogen bomb controversy.

Not Backing Down
Stevenson made it plain, however, in the seven talks he made in New York and surrounding suburbs Wednesday that he isn't backing down from his stand that this nation should take the lead in seeking an end to world hydrogen bomb tests.

Failure to reach agreement on how to end such tests, he said, doesn't mean agreement is "forever impossible."

"No matter which party wins in November, another supreme effort must be undertaken, and another, and another, too," he said.

Nixon Sees GOP Victory as 'Must' For Civil Rights

Chicago — (AP) — Vice President Richard M. Nixon said today the election of a Republican House and Senate on Nov. 6 is a must for the passage of civil rights legislation.

Nixon, in a speech prepared for delivery in the heart of Chicago's sprawling Negro community, said civil rights legislation "will never see the light of day" so long as Southern Democrats remain chairmen of key congressional committees.

Congress Must Back Ike
"Only by electing a Republican House and Senate and putting the committee chairmanships in the hands of men who support President Eisenhower's position will America be able to make the progress that all of us want toward the goal of equality of opportunity," Nixon said.

Nixon said the Eisenhower administration, if continued in office, will keep the civil rights pledges made in the GOP platform. These included Mr. Eisenhower's four-point program passed by the House but buried in the Senate last session calling for stronger federal anti-discrimination legislation.

Should Adlai E. Stevenson be elected, Nixon said, the civil rights story would be same as during the Truman administration—"a lot of talk, a lot of promises, but no action."
