**PEACE EFFORTS** Wayne Morse opposed the effort to stop shipment of jet fuel to Red China. Wayne Morse voted against the Formosa resolution, which brought peace to that area. Wayne Morse voted against the mutual defense treaty with Free China.

**ABOUT CRITICISM** When world confidence was so vital to strengthen the hand of President Eisenhower as he worked to stop the war in Korea, Wayne Morse described President Eisenhower as "the most dangerous man who will ever have been in the White House."
