London—Anthony Eden replying sharply to American criticism of not securing U. S. agreement before launching the Anglo-French attack upon Egypt.

"I do not think . . . that we must in all circumstances secure agreement from our American allies before we can act in our own vital interests."

Kansas City—Former President Truman charging the Eisenhower administration with "misleading" and "misinforming" the country on the international situation.

"It is also clear that the United States is no longer in fact the leader of the alliance of three nations. Seldom, if ever, has an American Chief Executive been treated with more humiliating indifference by friendly nations than President Eisenhower in the diplomatic events of the last few days."

Hannover, Ind.—Anthony Brewbaker, 16, who told police he shot his stepfather in a plot with his mother and blames it on a hitch-hiker. Quoting his mother on driving past a hitch-hiker before the crime.

## ADA President Says Fluoridation Is An Established Measure

Editor's Note: This is the third in a series of articles on fluoridation, being published in cooperation with the American Dental Association and the Jackson County Dental Association. Residents of Medford will vote next Tuesday on fluoridation of city water.)

Fluoridation is described by the president of the American Dental Association as "an established health measure that should be a routine procedure in every water department in the country."

Dr. Bernard C. Kingsbury of San Francisco states, "The safety and effectiveness are proved beyond doubt."

Used By Many  
There are now more than 1,400 communities embracing a population of 30 million people, where the drinking water is fluoridated. In addition, there are 3,570,000 people in some 1,100 communities, where fluorides occur naturally in the water in desirable amounts.

In all, according to American Dental Association statistics, one out of every four persons living in the U. S. urban communities is being served by water containing favorable amounts of fluorides.

For rural areas, where there is no public water supply, dentists have advocated topical fluoride treatment—application of fluorides directly to the surface of children's teeth by a dentist or dental hygienist.

Preventive Step  
The fluoridation movement has been described as the first concrete preventive step in dentistry. Because of the huge toll of dental decay, dentists have been hard-pressed to cope with the ravages of the disease. The backlog is bulking larger each year. The current rate of decay is six times the rate of repair.

It is estimated that 95 per cent of the American population is afflicted with dental decay. It reaches down to children as young as two. The benefits of fluoridation will be carried throughout a person's lifetime.

A study of adults, ages 35 to 44, living in water-fluoridated Colorado Springs, Colo., found they had only one-fourth the dental decay and tooth loss as the same age group in non-fluoridated Boulder.

Before the Commission on Chronic Illness reached its decision to recommend fluoridation of public water supplies in 1954, it investigated any possible harm to the aged persons of the nation.

Finding Reported  
A committee of scientists reported finding "no evidence that continued drinking of water containing fluorides at the recommended level (one part per million) is in any way harmful to health of adults or those suffering from chronic illness of any kind."

Two recent U. S. Public Health Service studies comparing death rates in 32 fluoride cities and 32 neighboring communities found them to be virtually the same for heart disease, cancer, brain lesions, cirrhosis of the liver and other leading causes of death.

Scientists warn fluoridation is not a cure-all. It must be accompanied by other well-established ways of reducing carries, including the restriction of carbohydrates and the practice of good oral hygiene.
