The photographer, a bachelor who lives with his parents, is enjoying fame with his project, which might explain it. His space club meetings in auditoriums draw hundreds of customers, including he says, space men disguised as earthlings.

"They've been sent to earth," he says, "to help people solve their problems—and this gets into religion."

The group, headed by President Gabriel Green, for months has been playing on local TV and radio stations a tape recording that predicts the space ship will hover over the orange groves and supermarkets Nov. 7.

On this recording, allegedly made by mental telephony from Mars, a celestial-sounding voice booms out the news that the saucers will sail into sight to prove they really exist.

With M-day approaching, I visited President Green to see how members of the SIGS were preparing for the event.

Green, a 31-year-old photographer for the Los Angeles city school system, has a problem: How to get a local TV or radio station to go off the air for two minutes when the saucers arrive.

"The men from Mars say they will speak to us on the wavelength of a station if that station will cease its programming," explained Green.

One station in San Luis Obispo (KATY) obligingly will observe two minutes of silence. But Green fears the station is too far away for the space men to be able to use it.

The space ship, he continued, is due at 10:30 p.m. Pacific Standard Time—apparently the
