West Coast Ships Wait Sail Orders

San Diego — (U.P.) — West Coast warships today were ordered to stand by for sailing orders because of the Mideastern crisis. The announcement was made by Vice Adm. Robert L. Dennison, commander of the First Fleet, and Vice Adm. Alfred M. Pride, commander of Air Forces of the Pacific Fleet. Wednesday night the giant aircraft carriers Wasp and the Philippine Sea were flooded with light at the San Diego Naval Air Station as crews presumably went on 24-hour loading operations. A spokesman for the First Fleet said exact details of the deployment orders and schedules were secret. He said the ships are based at San Diego, Long Beach and Alameda, Calif. "Certain Pacific Fleet units based at West Coast ports have been alerted to prepare for deployment to the Western Pacific," Dennison said. "Major units as well as supporting ships are involved." The Navy said no general orders cancelling leaves have been issued.

Hitting Utility Pole Found Expensive

Ogdensburg, N.Y. — (U.P.) — A local motorist found out that hitting a utility pole can be pretty expensive. Darrell Mills received an itemized bill for \$237.50 from the city water department after shearing off one of its poles. The damages included: \$175 for a new pole, \$15 for power for the department purchased, \$4.50 for operation of a gasoline motor during the interruption of electric service, \$31.20 for services of a pumping station attendant, \$12.05 to an electrician. And to make matters worse, Mills paid a \$25 fine after pleading guilty to speeding.

Bologna Server Saves 32 Lives

Milwaukee — (U.P.) — Maurice Bernier, 58, his retired from the police force here after 31 years and an amazing service record of saving 32 lives and serving a million bologna sandwiches. Bernier saved those 32 lives while he was working the early shift as jailer at the Safety Building. There were that many attempted suicides among prisoners, but they were saved by Bernier's alertness. He served up the huge mound of a million bologna sandwiches while serving as bailiff in district court. The sandwiches are the traditional noon-time repast of prisoners waiting in the bullpen for a court appearance.

Around Hollywood

Hollywood — (U.P.) — When Ed Wynn turns 79 Friday, he'll celebrate with a firm resolution: To look forward to his new career as a dramatic actor instead of dwelling on the 54 years of comedy behind him. While other veterans retire and read their press clippings, Wynn is proud that he's "beginning a second career in one lifetime." "I think of my comedy career as complete," Wynn said as he reflected on his future. "I was a comedian for 54 years and now I'm starting from scratch in supporting roles as an actor. I hope to build myself up to be a star in drama again." "The government," he added.

Specialty in Mink Diseases Demanding

New Holstein, Wis. — (U.P.) — Dr. G. R. Hartsough, a veterinarian in this small Calumet county city, has a specialty that brings calls for his services from throughout the country. Dr. Hartsough specializes in the treatment of mink diseases, and frantic appeals for aid from mink ranchers as far away as Oregon have brought him to the rescue. Mink ranchers claim the Wisconsin veterinarian knows more than any other man about the diseases that will send row upon row of the valuable animals keeling over without any apparent cause. Last year Dr. Hartsough traveled 75,000 miles by airplane and more than 35,000 miles by car to cure ailing mink. Much of his work is done in Wisconsin because this state's 700,000 domesticated minks represent about 30 per cent of the nation's output.

Skindivers Can't Match Diving Duck

Ithaca, N.Y. — (U.P.) — Try as they will, skindivers have a hard time trying to match the loon and diving duck. Researchers at Cornell University have found some physiological and anatomical characteristics that enable the loon and duck to excel at underwater sports. Scientists have found that spectacular changes in heart rate and differences in blood composition may be key factors permitting these aquatic birds to descend to depths as great as 200 feet. Prof. Perry W. Gilbert said these changes also may account for the fact that the birds can remain under water for as long as 15 minutes.

Blind Help Blind In Pennsylvania

Meyersdale, Pa. — (U.P.) — The blind are helping the blind to "see" in Pennsylvania. Sightless workmen here are making the red-tipped canes with which those without vision can "tap-tap" their way through a world of darkness. The cane factory is the only one in the nation operated by the blind themselves. Five persons are employed in the plant. They use converted broom machines to produce tapered canes which are lighter and more manageable than the commercial types. Gerel Croft, plant director and an executive of the Association for the Blind, said the factory "gives the cane a swaggy look." Croft said more than 500 agencies across the nation buy the canes for distribution to the blind. "The canes not only are useful gifts, but they are providing much-needed employment for the blind in western Pennsylvania," Croft said.
