Although the incidence of syphilis has been dropping steadily for the last 15 years, gonorrhea is not yet under good control. At a recent meeting, Dr. J. Earle Moore, of Johns Hopkins hospital reported that a few years ago the doctors in the clinic for venereal diseases saw some 40,000 patients every year, with some 2,000 new cases of syphilis. Today, the clinic wait-room is almost empty, and there are only a few cases of early syphilis. Men and women with late and active syphilis are too few even for teaching purposes in the medical school. This is one of the great things that penicillin has done for man.

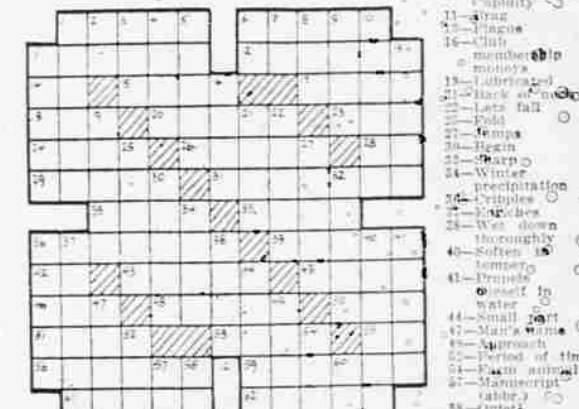

Balloonists Find Ride 'Intriguing'

Minneapolis—(U.P.)—Two Navy balloonists who rode an out-of-control balloon in a 14.6 mile plunge to earth said Friday they found the ride "intriguing."

Navy Commanders M. D. Ross and M. L. Lewis told a news conference they would be willing to make another ascent similar to their Thursday flight in a giant skyhook balloon which set a new manned-balloon altitude record of 76,000 feet.

Their expedition to gather scientific data at the fringe of outer space ended abruptly when the balloon began diving to earth because of a faulty valve that released too much helium.

Lewis said they were "concerned" but not "scared" during the rapid drop from the sky. But they said they did lose track of time during the descent and thought it was late afternoon when they stepped from the aluminum, pressurized gondola. Actually, it was just after 10 a.m. (MST).
