'Spacemen' Tested In Steel Chambers

New York—(U.P.)—"Spacemen" are taking regular excursions into six new steel test chambers to find out man's ability to withstand the rigors of outer space on a trip to the moon.

Tests are going on daily, reproducing an exact replica of conditions fliers will find at the rim of the ionosphere, 50 miles above the earth, and on into the exosphere, a zone of long-lasting stillness.

Steelways, official publication of American Iron and Steel Institute, says that when the key to man's behavior above and beyond the sonic barrier has been unlocked a trip to the moon will be closed to reality.

The recently installed test chambers at the Air Research and Development Command's Center near Dayton, Ohio, are designed to measure man's capacity to act under hitherto unmeasurable conditions and lead to special training aimed at bringing him back to earth safe and sound.

It said that with the aid of the new test chambers, which can simulate altitudes higher than ever before possible, 100,000 feet or nearly 19 miles, researchers are enabled to probe more deeply into and more mystifying sources of human failure.

Although crop-dusting is no longer a new practice in Texas, other aerial operations as applied to farming have grown.

Many rice farmers along the Gulf Coast in the southeast part of the state hire aviation concerns to sow and fertilize their rice crops from the air.

Sowing of wheat and other small grain crops has been experimented with in other parts of the state.
