**Boston To Chicago Time Will Be Cut**

Boston — (U.P.) — Two years from now northeastern motorists will be driving almost as the crow flies, sweeping over multi-laned highways which will take them from Boston to Chicago in less than a day.

Massachusetts Turnpike authorities predict that, in 1958, the missing links in the turnpike chain will be almost completed, enabling travelers to go virtually non-stop from the Hub to the Loop.

The super-speed roads will cut more than six hours from the 28 now required to cover the route. But there is one link which may not be complete in time for the magic span predicted for 1958.

That's the toll road gap of some 100 miles between the New York-Pennsylvania line, near Erie, to the Ohio turnpike. No plans for a toll road in that area have been announced as yet.

Only one other condition mars the "dream route." Motorists must pay for the time they save. Estimates now are that the drive will cost approximately \$10 in toll costs alone.

**Job Stabilization Automation Purpose**

Chicago — (U.P.) — If automation does nothing else but help stabilize jobs, it will have served its purpose, an industrial training expert says.

Arthur C. Studd, manager of education and training for Hotpoint Corp., expressed this view at a conference on automation sponsored by Armour Research Foundation of the Illinois Institute of Technology.

"Automation is America's hope for continuing growth in the future," Studd said. "He said it will serve 'increasingly' as a general stabilizer of the economy.

"Automation programs require long-range, detailed planning of capital investment," he said, "and the pursuit of these plans, regardless of temporary ups and downs in annual sales."

As automation and mechanization are introduced into a company's operations, fixed costs go up, he pointed out. "With high investments in machinery, industry has one more incentive to keep these machines running as steadily as possible," Studd said.

"This provides a great stimulus for better planning, more professional marketing, and all the other techniques for maintaining steady demand and employment."
