National Grange Hears Resolutions At Annual Parley

Rochester, N. Y. (U.P.)—Resolutions were presented to the 90th annual convention of the National Grange yesterday. Penalties ranging up to life imprisonment for peddlers of illicit drugs, and taxes on the liquor industry to finance the care and cure of alcoholics were among proposals made.

The National Grange also taken at all levels of government to curtail, prohibit and outlaw "foul" publications.

A report of the Committee on Education and Health said that rural health conferences are resulting in better understanding between rural people and the medical profession through cooperation of several allied organizations.

In Railroad Car Planes Designed

New York (U.P.)—Three of the nation's most famous types of planes were designed in a railroad car and two hotel rooms.

Harold Mansfield, author of a new book on aviation, "Vision," reveals that the B-52, our top global jet bomber, was designed in a hotel room in Dayton, Ohio, on a Saturday night by five aeronautical experts.

The Monomial, the first smooth-metal transport plane, was pioneered by Edward Hubbard and Claire Egtvedt. They were in a Los Angeles hotel room during the 1928 air races and sketched their ideas on hotel stationery.

On a visit to England, Francis Cabot Lowell, a young Boston merchant, memorized details of a power loom and reproduced it, thus establishing the American cotton manufacturing industry in 1814.
