

Farm Journal Editor To Speak at Meeting

Corvallis — Oregon fruit and vegetable growers will have Wheeler McMillen, editor and vice president of Farm Journal magazine, as principal speaker at the Oregon State Horticultural Society annual meeting,

Dec. 6 and 7, at Oregon State college. The nationally known editor will speak at 1:30 p.m. Dec. 6, following the welcome address by Dr. John R. Richards, Chancellor, Oregon State system of higher education.

Gordon Walker, Independence, president of the society, estimated that 1,000 growers will attend the first annual meeting. The convention opens Dec. 6, with four special sectional meetings for growers of apples and pears, stone fruit, small fruits and vegetables. Program topics for the separate group meetings were picked by committees assigned six months ago to investigate major production and marketing problems in key fruit and vegetable areas of Oregon.

Also participating in the program will be four Medford men. R. M. James will be chairman of the apple and pear section; John Higdon will speak on thinning Bartlett pears; Gordon Kerstow will give growers' observations of rootstocks on the Pacific Northwest; and Higdon and County Agent Clifford Cordy will participate in a panel discussion on pear virus and the stony pit situation in Oregon.

PUC Discusses Future of Trolley Service

Portland — (U.P.) — The future status of the Oregon City and Bellrose Interurban lines was argued before the Oregon Public Utilities Commission today.

Construction on the approaches of the Hawthorne and Morrison bridges in Portland has forced a halt in the interurban bus passenger travel directly to the west side business district.

Patrons claimed that the shuttle bus service is unsatisfactory in that no waiting rooms are provided and that the shuttle buses do not run on a schedule, necessitating long waits.

Glenn A. Klein, county extension agent for 4-H club work, Medford, pointed out that "Carl has won four 4-H club, summer school scholarships and three county and one state forestry awards for tree identification." Skyrman is past president of the Central Point 4-H Forestry Club. A senior at Crater High school, he has been a member of the track team, a reporter on the student paper and active in the Sportsman's club. He plans to enter Oregon State college and major in forestry next fall. The 4-H forestry program is administered throughout Oregon by county extension agents for 4-H club work. APPI, donor of the awards, is national sponsor of the industry supported American Tree Farm, system of privately owned, tax paying lands, growing timber as a crop for perpetual harvests.

State Tax Collections \$36,839,964 for Year

Salem — (U.P.) — The State Tax Commission has reported it had collected \$36,839,964 in taxes this fiscal year through Oct. 31 as compared with \$13,788,740 for the same four-month period last year. The fiscal year started July 1. Some \$28,949,305 of the collections were in personal income tax compared with \$13,788,740 collected at this time last year. Corporation excise taxes totaled \$7,489,926 compared with \$4,912,234 collected last year. Corporation income taxes returned \$41,304 to the state this year.
