Plans for Increasing Facilities at State Fair Are Discussed

A committee of Jackson county residents interested in improving facilities at the Oregon State Fair 4-H and Future Farmers of America members met at Crater High school recently to discuss plans proposed by the state-wide committee organized earlier this fall.

It was pointed out that both the youth programs have outgrown facilities available in the dormitory and non-livestock exhibit areas.

Machinery exhibits were stacked on top of each other or left at home because of lack of space and boys were sleeping on the ground for lack of other suitable sleeping facilities, the committee noted. The combined 4-H and FFA programs have increased more than 10 times the former exhibit volume and increase each year.

Plans have been drawn for the construction of a new dormitory, cafeteria, auditorium and exhibit building for use by 4-Hers and FFA members. The facilities have been so designed so that they may be used year

around by not only 4-H and FFA groups but by farm organizations and other groups meeting in the Willamette Valley which would have need for such facilities.

House 380 People
The dormitory would house 380 people, the cafeteria is designed to feed more than 500 and the auditorium would seat more than 600 people.

The local group noted that Jackson county had more boys and girls staying at the dormitory this year than any other county. Committee plans call for the introduction of a bill to the forthcoming legislature for a direct appropriation of the funds needed to build these facilities.

County committee members present were Mrs. Clinton Charley, Central Point; Don Nichols, Ashland; Stan Zapell, Talent and Mrs. John Bohnert, Central Point, chairman. Mrs. Bohnert said information can be obtained from any of the committee members, local vocational agriculture instructors or the county agent's office.

Committee Seeking to Find Out How Much Help Needed

Young women left with children either through desertion by the father or his death may often inquire as to where to go to receive help in determining what is best for herself and children, according to Jackson County Mental Health committee.

The young mother, in an example cited by the committee, does not feel secure in her own ability to do what should be done for the family since the father has gone, yet she does not want to take work because she feels her children need her.

She was unhappy just caring for the children at home without a chance to get out.

She had been an unhappy child and teenager, self conscious and unable to assert herself in classes or the few groups to which she belonged. Yet, she did not want to discuss her feelings with her minister, and during school conferences about her children she tended to "lean on" the teacher for advice. The teachers did not feel equipped, nor had they the time to assist in the mother's problem.

The Mental Health committee is conducting a survey through which it hopes to determine how many such cases there are in Jackson county. The committee also hopes to learn how to help such situations, whether planning to work, and if so what arrangements can be made with the children, and to resolve her inferior feelings about meeting and socializing with people.

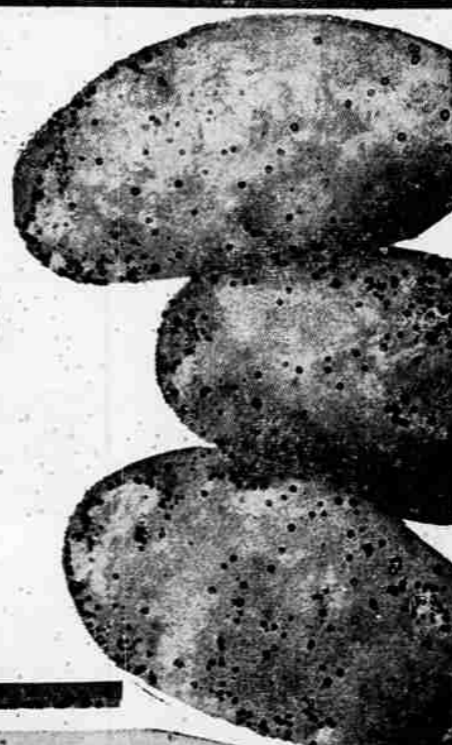
