Family Council

Fred D.—I can't accept support from my parents. Marcia D.—He's wasting himself now. Fred D.—My wife and I were married five years ago while we were both still in college...

However, our first baby was born a year and a half after we were married and now there is a second on the way. I have had to give up my studies. I was willing to do this and I can be happy with my job, which gives us a decent income, and my nice family. But my wife isn't satisfied.

Marcia went behind my back to my parents and told them I wanted to resume my studies. She asked for their financial help. They said they would give it if I really wanted it.

My parents were opposed to my marrying when I did because they felt it would interfere with my career. I can't accept support from them now.

Marcia D.—My husband happens to have outstanding abilities. It was this that attracted me to him in the first place. If I had known he would settle down into a commonplace life, doing nothing important, I wouldn't have married him.

Fred's parents are just as disappointed in him as I am, and have the means to help him. I wouldn't ask for much and I would be willing to make every sacrifice. I didn't want to go to them behind his back, but he refused to go himself.

I feel very guilty at having spoiled his career. Fred is now wasting himself and knows it. He doesn't want to hold it against me, but I know that deep in his heart he is sorry. Many of his friends without half his ability have gone so much further. If we put it off any longer, there will be nothing we can do to save Fred's future.

Marcia was dead wrong to go to Fred's parents behind his back. Her attitude is that of a greedy child, who must get exactly what she has set her heart upon, by fair means or foul. Marcia needs to grow up and understand that she is deeply undermining her husband and her marriage—and these are more important than her dream of some vague, brilliant future. Despite his wife's childishness, however, Fred ought to seriously consider his parents' offer. If his parents have the means to help him and he deeply desires a professional career, it would be foolish to sacrifice it for the sake of his pride.
