

School Integration Faces Major Tests

Clinton, Tenn. — (U.P.) — The campaign for racial integration in Southern schools headed today for a major test on two fronts in the hills of eastern Tennessee.

In the tense city of Clinton, officials of the integrated high school again started integrated operations after almost 3 1/2 months of strife over the racial issue.

The eight Negroes in the 700-member student body attended Monday and were expected back in class this morning.

Police planned to keep a close watch on the situation indefinitely.

Nearby, Knoxville became the center of a legal battle that could set the pattern for the federal government's enforcement efforts in the segregation controversy. A group of 16 persons were arrested Monday on charges of interfering with Clinton High's integration.

Clinton High school—the first state-supported public school in Tennessee to mix the races—had resumed regular classes without protest from students or organized segregationists. The school had been closed since a week ago today.

The FBI continued its investigation of the Clinton affair. Agents were expected to be observing the daily trek to the classroom again, as they were Monday.

Bob Garred Funeral Services Planned

Holbrook — (U.P.) — Funeral services were being arranged today for veteran radio-television announcer Bob Garred.

Garred, 41, died Monday after suffering a heart attack in Ardmore, Okla., where he was on an assignment for American Broadcasting Co.

His body was returned here Monday night. Funeral services have tentatively been set for Garred's home town of Walla Walla, Wash. The body of the veteran of 20 years in radio will be flown to Washington Wednesday.

Seaton To Discuss Power Situation

Washington — (U.P.) — Interior Secretary Fred A. Seaton will discuss the entire Pacific Northwest power situation with private power company officials at a meeting here in the near future, it was reported today.

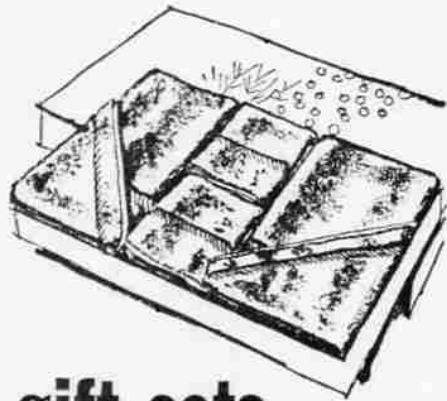
