Citrus Fruit Crop Forecast

Washington (U.P.)—The Agriculture Department has forecast the 1956-57 production of citrus fruits at 140,915,000 boxes of oranges and tangerines, 43,300,000 boxes of grapefruit, and 13,600,000 boxes of lemons.

The department estimated production of early and midseason oranges at 70.7 million boxes, 3 per cent more than last year, and 26 per cent above average.

Grapefruit production was expected to be 5 per cent smaller than last year and 10 per cent below average.

Chest X-Ray Clinic To Close Christmas

The chest x-ray clinic at Sacred Heart hospital will be closed the last two weeks this month, according to the Jackson County Public Health association which operates the clinic.

A total of 3,435 persons had chest x-rays at the out-patient clinic this year, the committee reported. Approximately 12 per cent of the people were referred to their doctors because of chest or heart conditions revealed by the x-rays.

Members of the Providence Guild assist the association in operating the clinic by donating a total of 56 1/2 hours a month volunteer work.

Persons who were planning to have their chest x-rays this month have been urged to attend Thursday between 2 and 5 p.m.
