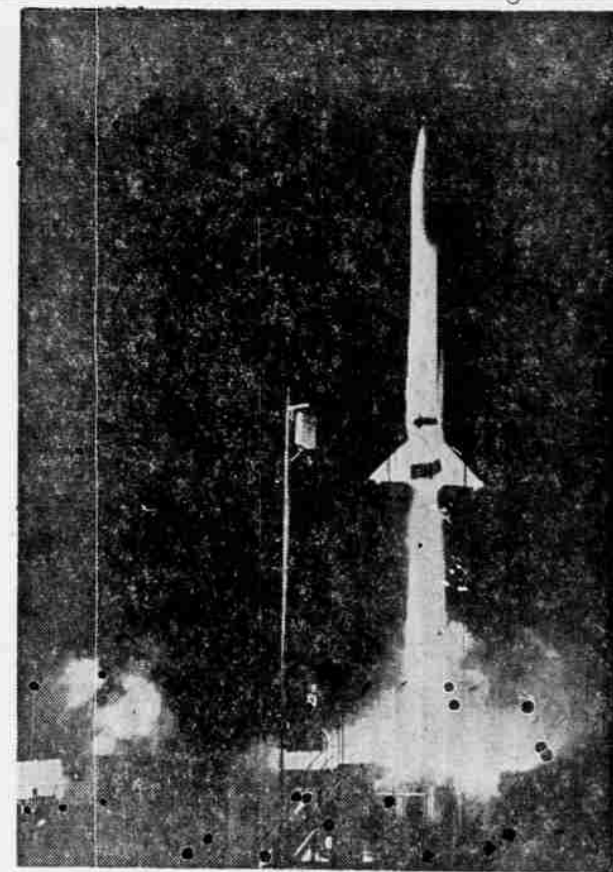

Airmen Due Training In City Wrecking Ballistic Missiles

Washington (UPI)—The Air Force next month will start training airmen in how to fire city wrecking ballistic missiles which are destined to revolutionize air-atomic warfare. It probably will be several years, however, before the airmen will have the actual weapons in hand. The Air Force announced late Wednesday that it will establish a training base on the West Coast for ballistic missile units. The training center will be located at Camp Cooke, Lompoc, Calif., an inactive Army base which will be transferred to Air Force control. To Occupy in January The Air Force will start occupying the base in January and gradually build up to a 3,000 to 4,000-man strength. The contemplated manpower is an indication that the base will be the Air Force's principal center for training the ballistic missilemen of the future.

President May Be Asked To Intervene In Rail Dispute

Chicago (UPI)—The National Mediation Board has indicated it may seek presidential intervention in a dispute between the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen and 140 carriers. Negotiations collapsed Wednesday when the brotherhood rejected a contract and wage offer by the nation's railroads and refused to arbitrate the dispute. No Strike Vote Taken Spokesmen said the mediation board is expected to inform President Eisenhower that an emergency exists in an effort to avert a possible strike. However, Vernon W. Saterwhite, assistant to Big Brother William P. Kennedy, said no strike vote has been taken as yet. Union negotiators representing 135,000 operating trainmen turned down an offer of a 2 1/2 percent hourly pay boost over a three-year period. The union said it rejected the offer because the railroads failed to include clauses reducing the hours of dining car stewards and boosting the number of paid holidays to seven. The union had demanded a \$3 a day pay increase for dining car stewards, yardmasters, yard and road service workers and other smaller groups. The union also sought an extra \$2.50 per day for employees on short turnaround service. Under the railway labor act, President Eisenhower could declare an emergency and appoint a fact finding board to investigate the dispute. The act also provides for a delay of 60 days or longer on any strike action.
