Catholic Scholarship Plan Creates Teachers

Pittsburgh—(U.P.)—Pittsburgh district Catholic schools will gain the teaching services of 220 girls under a program in operation here.

The Catholic Diocesan School System sponsored a scholarship program three years ago, paying all the college tuition costs of 220 top students. In exchange, the coeds will teach in local Catholic schools as soon as they are graduated.

The program is expected to relieve a critical shortage of teachers for the 109,000 pupils enrolled in Pittsburgh district Catholic schools.

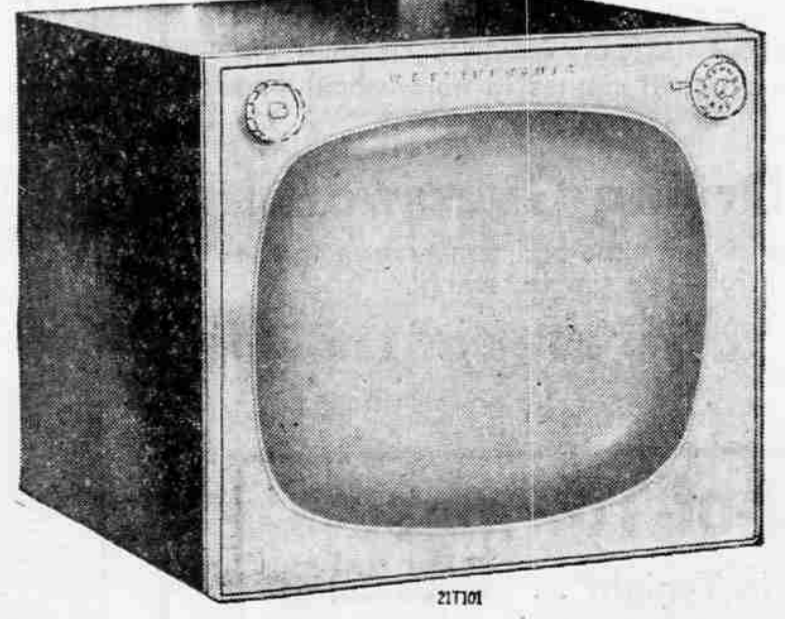
