## The Medical Roundup

### New Research on Mental Disease

The other day, in the city of Washington, 700 delegates attended a two-day National Conference on the Evaluation of Pharmacotherapy in Mental Illness. Pharmacotherapy is a long word for drug-treatment. The conference was sponsored by the American Psychiatric Association, the National Academy of Sciences and the National Institute of Mental Health. My friend, Dr. Ralph Gerard, one of our ablest brain physiologists, was chairman of the conference. As Dr. Seymour Kety said, there is urgent need today for much more investigation of the type which is now going on, in which much is being learned about the functions of the brain from the way in which these functions respond to drugs of various kinds.

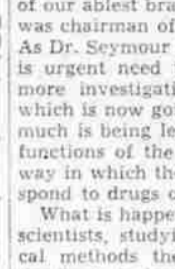
What is happening is that real scientists, studying with technical methods the physiology of the brain in health and disease, are now walking off into research laboratories and leaving the analysts to amuse themselves with their theories. As a sample of the theorizing of these men, I was just reading the weird and most improbable statements of one of them who is reported to have said that, of late, there has been a tremendous increase in homosexuality due to the fact that when Kinsey wrote his book, in which he showed how common homosexuality is, thousands of homosexualists rushed to see Dr. Kinsey and in some as yet unexplained way, became much more homosexual than they had ever been before!

According to Maj. Louis J. West, and M/Sgt. Wm. H. Swegan, the Air Force, by a better handling of the problem of alcoholism, has already saved more than a million dollars. As the writers say, the cost of training a good jet pilot ranges up to \$500,000 while the cost of training an electronics technician is about \$75,000. The training of even a private can run to \$15,000.

## Strawberry Growers Benefit

Geneva, N. Y. — (UP)—Strawberry growers should benefit from some research recently concluded at the New York State Agricultural Experiment Station here.

Experiments with six leading strawberry varieties during the past two seasons show that many more berries to the plant are obtained where strawberries are grown by the single-plant or "hill" system than from plants grown in the matted row system generally used in New York.

John P. Tomkins, Cornell and State University small fruit specialist, reported that under the hill system plants produced an average of 4,200 quarts per acre more than the same sorts grown in matted rows.

The report concerning the past season which was not a favorable one for strawberries, disclosed the larger yield was due to a greatly increased number of berries per plant rather than to larger berries.

The hill system, as practiced at the station, consists of setting plants in three rows with 12 inches between rows and 12 inches between plants in the row, and with a 30-inch alley between each group of three rows, Tomkins explained. In the matted row system, plants are set two feet apart in rows four and a half feet apart.

In my day, caps were bought by lazy men who thought it proper to touch the bill instead of lifting the lid.

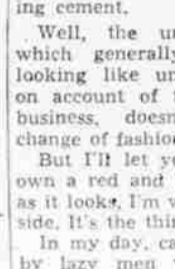
