Irate Dog Catcher Kills Two Men in Montana Bar

Shelby Mont.—(U.P.) — A 34-year-old parttime dog catcher, angered after an argument about a dog, shot and killed two men with a single bullet from a high powered rifle here yesterday, Sheriff Thomas Connelly said.

Jess DeWeest, who lives in a shack near the city dump and earns a living gathering scrap and dogs, turned himself in to police officers.

Killed in the early morning barroom shooting were "Red" Sullivan, about 50, Shelby, an itinerant worker, and Gordon Lyle, about 30, Joplin, Mont., County Attorney William

Black was investigating and said he expected to charge DeWeest with first degree murder.

Connelly said DeWeest had been seen arguing with Sullivan about an hour before the shooting over a dog DeWeest had picked up.

He said DeWeest returned to his shack after the argument where he picked up a 30-40 caliber rifle and returned to the Aibi Night Club on Shelby's main street.

"This is it" The sheriff said DeWeest then walked in the door of the bar, told Sullivan "this is it" and opened fire.

Lyle was standing behind Sullivan. The bullet went through Sullivan's chest and struck the

other man, killing both instantly.

DeWeest then walked across the street to another bar and told a bartender to call police.

"I've just shot two men," he said.
