Baton Rouge Maps Quiet Integration

Atlanta - (UPI) - Bus integration campaigners in Baton Rouge, La., met with city officials yesterday to try to avoid strife and violence that has marked similar campaigns in Alabama and Florida. A cross-burning Saturday night at the home of the Rev. T. J. Jemison, Negro leader of the integration movement, marked the first lawlessness of a heretofore quiet Baton Rouge campaign. Except for a minor incident in which teen-age boys hurled spark plugs, damaging a city bus Saturday at Montgomery, Ala., relative quiet prevailed over the week end at other so-called bus integration centers.

The Jukes: A Tribe of Degenerates

In 1874 the New York Prison Association commissioner Robert L. Dugdale to visit 13 jails and to report on the conditions found. While doing this, Dugdale kept running into members of a group of closely-related persons, practically all of them petty criminals, vagrants, alcoholics, prostitutes, paupers, and queer persons. Soon he discovered that they were all descendants of a good-for-nothing man named Max Juke, who came into a certain county in New York about 1700. He lived by hunting and fishing, and was averse to taking any kind of a steady job.

As the years passed his descendants bred remarkably true; and as a result their family name became a term of opprobrium. Many of these people lived in tumble-down old shacks and hovels; all ages and sexes and even visiting strangers "bunking" on the floor together. An old doctor who had lived in their neighborhood for 30 years was able to give Dugdale the genealogy of most of the members of the clan. Eventually, Dugdale traced and visited 540 direct blood relatives of old Juke, and 169 men and women who had married into the tribe. He estimated that there must have been some 1200 in the whole group. Many of the women were prostitutes and many of the children were illegitimate. Most of them were early deserted by their mentally retarded and irresponsible parents, and left to fend for themselves.

Petty Crime Hereditary

Harlotry seemed to be a hereditary characteristic of the women, and petty crime and vagrancy was hereditary among the men. Naturally, the intelligence of these people did not seem to have been very high. Some were definitely morose and some were insane. Many of them drank to excess. As one might have expected, only about one in five learned a trade that required any skill, and some of these men did not work steadily. One in four had no occupation. As Dugdale said, one of the reasons why the children in generation after generation did so poorly was that in most cases their home life was awful, and nine out of 10 were early left to shift for themselves. Naturally, through the years, the state had had to pay out large sums for the care of these people in prisons and poor-houses. About the only hope Dugdale could see for the improvement of this tribe would be through the supplying of better homes for the children.

Twin Boys Succumb In Fire at Alturas

Alturas, Calif. - (UPI) - Twin boys died Sunday night when fire destroyed a small cabin in which they were sleeping here. The victims were Ronald and Russell Richards, 6. Police Chief Darrell Rachford said the boys and an older brother were sleeping in the cabin behind the Richards residence when the fire broke out, apparently from an overheated stove.

Eastern Nigeria Hopes For Major Oil Strike

Lagos, Nigeria - (UPI) - Hopes of a major oil strike in Eastern Nigeria has risen with the announcement by Britain's Shell-BP Petroleum company that it had found more oil at Oloibiri. Two previous strikes of oil at Oloibiri led experts to believe a major oilfield lies beneath the steamy jungle. Experts said it was likely Nigeria's first commercial oilfield would be operating there within a few months.
