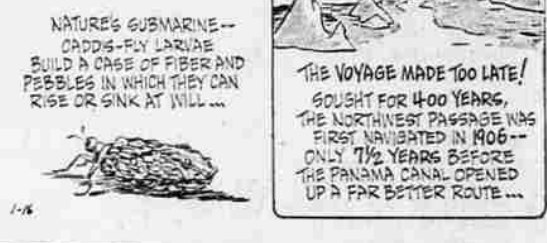

CROSSWORD PUZZLE

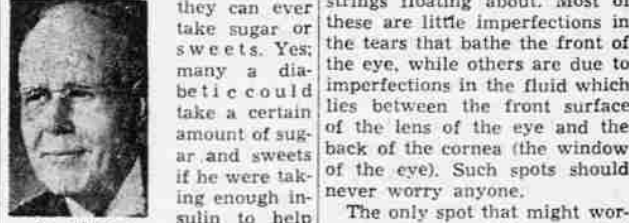

Should a Diabetic Ever Eat Sugar and Sweets? Diabetic persons, and especially those who are taking insulin, often want to know if they can ever take sugar or sweets.



Dr. Alvarez: There are two schools of thought in the treatment of diabetes; some physicians prefer that a diabetic go as far as he can in the control of his disease by cutting down on the use of sugar and starches and sweets.

There are two important points in the handling of diabetes; one is that the diabetic ought to stay thin. If he allows himself to get stout, he is likely to get arteriosclerosis, and he is likely to lose his life because of that.
