Gomulka Indicates Shakeup in Poland

Warsaw — (U.P.) — Communist party leader Wladyslaw Gomulka has named a new Polish ambassador to Moscow in what is believed the first step in a sweeping post-election shakeup of the administration and party.

An official announcement said Tadeusz Gede, a former deputy premier, has been appointed to replace Wladyslaw Lewikowski as an ambassador to Russia.

Gede is neither a Stalinist conservative nor Gomulka liberal member of the Communist party. However, it was obvious by his appointment that he was acceptable to both Moscow and the new Warsaw leadership.
