Does The Ovarian Hormone Cause Cancer?

We doctors have some peculiar habits, and one is to get an unreasoning fear of some practically harmless drug, while at the same time, we prescribe it freely for anyone who needs it. A couple of British research workers say in their paper that the thousands of women who take birth control pills are not producing cancer. It is only when a person is treated with big doses of x-rays, as for a cancer, that years later there might be some trouble.

Several persons have begun worrying about the tiny amount of radiation that can come off the hands of a watch or clock, but such worry is foolish.

Around Hollywood

Hollywood—U.P.—This is the year when calypso eclipses rock 'n' roll, and the Andrews Sisters are proud to have started the West Indian music fad, despite pokes to the contrary from Harry Belafonte.

Back in 1942, Maxine, Patty and Laverne came out with "Rum and Coca Cola" which they claim introduced calypso to the American public. Their record sold 5 million copies.

"What's wrong with changing lyrics Maxine asked. 'We bet Belafonte has, too. The tune we used was identical to the original we heard from a West Indian calypso singer.'"

This year, thanks to Belafonte's album and a song called "Banana Boat," calypso is beginning to push rock 'n' roll off the juke boxes. It appears to be the musical fad of 1957.

Authenticity Challenged
Belafonte recently charged the Andrews Sisters' "Rum and Coca Cola" was not "authentic" calypso. But the girls—still the top trio of the entertainment business—say they truly were 15 years ahead of their time.

"A calypso singer named the Duke of Iron sang the song to me after a friend of ours, Maurety Amsterdam, went to the islands and heard it," explained Patti.

Explosion Rocks Klamath Plant

Klamath Falls — (U.P.) — An explosion at the Klamath Lumber and Box Company plant in north Klamath Falls caused an estimated \$25,000 damage yesterday.

Fifteen men had just gone to work at the plant but no injuries were reported.

Plant officials said the blast apparently was caused by friction. The blast shattered the top wheel of a band saw which is eight feet in diameter and weighs about one ton.

Fragments of steel were blown about 200 feet into the air. Windows were broken, a hole was blown in the roof and the north and south walls of the building were shattered.

Roland Cantrill, manager at the plant, estimated that operations at the plant would be disrupted for about two weeks.

Court Will Study Costello Sentence

Washington—(U.P.)—The Supreme Court has agreed to decide whether to stiff a prison sentence was imposed on New York underworld leader Frank Costello for income tax evasion.

Costello, serving a five-year sentence for understating his income from 1947 through 1949, claims he was sentenced under the wrong federal law. He has asked the court to rule that he should be punished under a different statute which puts a one-year limit on jail terms.

The high court, which previously upheld Costello's 1953 conviction, will schedule arguments on the new legal point later this year and then hand down a decision.
