Tito May Cancel Trip To U.S. Because of Anti-Yugoslav Feeling

Belgrade, Yugoslavia —(UP)—The Communist Party newspaper Borba strongly hinted today President Tito will cancel his planned visit to Washington because of anti-Yugoslav sentiment in the United States.

A special article written by Borba's foreign political editor, Jozef Smole, took particular notice of reports the United States planned to slip Tito in and out of Washington while Congress was in recess so he would not have to address the lawmakers.

"It is to be expected that our government, if it has not done so already, will inform the American government clearly that in such circumstances the visit cannot be carried out," the newspaper said.

Borba did not say Tito had cancelled the visit officially, but since it is the official Communist Party newspaper there was little doubt Tito was thinking of going so. The article was distributed by the official Tass News Agency, thus adding to the authenticity of the views set forth by Smole.

New York Man Will Succeed Lundeberg

San Francisco —(UP)— Paul Hall of New York succeeded Harry Lundeberg today as president of the Seafarers International Union of North America.

Hall, who is first vice president of the international union founded by Lundeberg in 1938, will hold the job until the biennial convention elects a permanent successor March 25.

Lundeberg died Monday of a heart attack at the age of 55.

Hall arrived here Tuesday to attend the funeral. Accompanying him was Morris Weisberger, New York port agent for the Sailors Union of the Pacific.

Lundeberg was secretary-treasurer of this union, which represents West Coast sailors.

Weisberger is prominent among those mentioned to succeed Lundeberg as secretary-treasurer of the SUP, the top job in that union.

Hungarian Reds Eye Reinstatements

Vienna —(UP)—The Hungarian Communist Party is preparing for the return to grace of the die-hard Stalinists purged after the October revolution, reports from Budapest indicated today.

The party newspaper Nep Szabadsag today printed a "demand" by activists of the Szolnok (eastern Hungary) Party organization calling for a review of the expulsions.

Many followers of "Stalinist" Matyas Rakosi, former party boss, were expelled last November in the desperate attempt by Janos Kadar to appease the still-rebellious Hungarian people.

"Old potato head," as Rakosi was known, resigned as party leader during the summer in the de-Stalinization campaign which swept over the satellites in the wake of Soviet Communist Party boss Nikita S. Khrushchev's denunciation of Josef Stalin.

The Szolnok activists, Communist terminology for active party agitators, demanded all expulsions should be re-examined and each case considered on an individual basis.
