Glendora, Calif. —(U.P.)—Repairs began today on Vincent Carta's \$20,000 home which was almost wrecked in a search for a "ghost cat" whose haunting cries turned out to be a squeaky water meter instead of the cat's meow.

Carta, whose family was plagued with the cries ever since moving into their new house nearly a month ago, sighed with relief and said that he and his wife and their two small children could now return to "normal lives."
