Around Hollywood

Hollywood —(U.P.)— How to combat the movie star shortage and also beat the dwindling United States movie business: Hire a foreign film favorite.

Germany's O. W. Fischer is the latest box-office success of Europe to be imported for a Hollywood picture by Universal-International studio. Last year U-I signed Rossano Brazzi for a film.

Mike Todd outdid all the producers by using an international cast in "Around the World in 80 Days" to insure its boxoffice success the world around.

Foreign imports have a double advantage for Hollywood. For one thing, top stars are as scarce in Hollywood because so few new luminaries have hit the top. Only a handful of graying actors and actresses control the top jobs. Good scripts go begging for lack of stars to play them.

Foreign Patrons Important

Furthermore, 55 per cent of a Hollywood film's revenue comes from outside the United States. The patrons of theaters in Tokyo, Rome, Berlin and Glasgow are as important—or more so—to movie producers than American fans.

Fischer, No. 1 at the boxoffice in his country, was lured to Hollywood by a remake of the William Powell-Carole Lombard success of 21 years ago, "My Man Godfrey." The Vienna-born actor plays a venereal Austrian courtier hired as a butler by the pert June Allyson.

Blond, handsome Fischer arrived in Hollywood last week for his first visit to the United States, leaving his wife and five cats at home.

Good Script Attracts Actor

"The studio asked me to come here and I said I would when they offered a good script—and they did," the suave, poised actor said between scenes on the set. "I now have signed for five pictures at the studio, when scripts are available. Meanwhile, I will return to my home in Germany."

Fischer is a veteran of the stage and 42 films in Germany and Italy but has never before appeared in an American movie.

U-I has become a leader in importing stars. Besides Brazzi and Fischer, the studio brought in Germany's Cornell Borchers and plans to hire Curt Jurgens, another German boxoffice favorite, and Helmut Kautner, top German director. Anna Magnani, Kay Kendall and Diana Dors are among other foreign imports who are giving an international flavor to Hollywood movies.

Nixon Asked To Attend Gold Coast Celebration

Washington —(U.P.)—The White House has announced that President Eisenhower has asked Vice President Richard M. Nixon to represent the United States at ceremonies in March celebrating the independence of the Gold Coast in Africa.

The Gold Coast is the first British colony in tropical Africa to receive independence. On March 6 it will become a member of the British Commonwealth.

Merchant Seamen on Trial for Assault

San Rafael, Calif. —(U.P.)—Two Southern California merchant seamen went on trial here Tuesday on charges of assaulting longshore leader Harry Bridges in a Sausalito restaurant last Sept. 21.

The defendants were Fred Reppine, 35, and Donald C. Hansen, 28, both members of the Sailors Union of the Pacific—a bitter rival of Bridges' International Longshoremen's and Warehousemen's Union.

District Attorney William O. Weissich said Bridges would not be called as a witness, but his testimony given at a preliminary hearing would be read into the trial record.
