Hollywood — (U.P.) — Nominations for the most confused election in history will be televised Saturday night — and the producers of the show are placidly expecting "screams" and complaints.

For the first time, the Academy of Television Arts and Sciences will televise its Emmy nominees because NBC feels armchair critics are anxious to compare their lists of favorites with those of the industry voters.

But this will be one awards show on which the nominations will be sandwiched between entertainment instead of vice versa.

Only the 10 "personality" nominees out of 25 categories will be announced on the program. The other nominees will have to wait and read about themselves in the newspapers.

Entertainment Comes First

"Every nominee who isn't mentioned on the show probably will scream, but we feel the entertainment should come first," explains producer Alan Handley.

Because the networks think this industry salute "rises above any other consideration," NBC got rivals CBS and ABC to send over their stars, making the show one big happy family variety program, Phil Silvers, Danny Thomas, John Daly, Jane Bryan, Peggy King and Kugla Fran and Ollie will appear.

Creation of New Material Told by General Electric

New York—(U.P.)—Creation of an entirely new material, as hard as a diamond and twice as resistant to heat, has been announced by the General Electric Company.

The material, called borazon, was developed in the same Schenectady laboratory in which man-made diamonds first were produced some two years ago.

The material is a combination of boron and nitrogen forced into a cubic structure under pressures of 1 million pounds a square inch and temperatures of 3,000 degrees Fahrenheit in a container about the size of an eraser on a pencil, the company said.

Credit for its development was given to Dr. Robert H. Wentorf Jr., 30, a physical chemist and native of West Bend, Wis.

Borazon will scratch a diamond, and a diamond will scratch it, indicating they are of about equal hardness. But whereas a diamond oxidizes at about 1,600 degrees Fahrenheit, borazon does not burn until temperatures reach about 3,500 degrees.
