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Effectiveness of GOC To Be Tested

The West Air Defense command Saturday will run a test of the effectiveness of Civilian Ground Observer Corps Skywatch installations in southern Oregon and northern California, according to Sgt. Clifford Paulson, GOC representative here.

One or more B-29 bombers will take off from Hamilton Air Force base, Calif., Saturday morning, following a flight plan to cover both inland and coastal points of the southern Oregon and northern California area.

Plans for testing effectiveness were originated by Sam Price, a radio station announcer and member of the GOC. Maj. Gen. Joseph Hicks, Jackson County Civil Defense director and Sergeant Paulson.

Sergeant Paulson and Price were to leave Medford early this morning for Hamilton Air Force base, near San Francisco, Calif.

Price will be present on the flight to make on the spot progress reports for broadcast over station KMED when they become available. They will return to Medford Sunday.
