Hypochondriasis

Years ago an elderly Syrian came to see me; I may have mentioned him before in this column. He came with a nurse whose job it was to keep him alive a little longer. He looked the picture of health, but he told me that he had spent years going from one clinic to another being thoroughly examined. He was sure that he had a cancer of the stomach, but no one could find it.

Because this was during the war years when I was terribly overworked, I said, "If I were to get a surgeon to operate on you under local anesthesia and to pull your stomach out of your abdomen; and if then he were to show you that there isn't anything wrong with it, would you go home satisfied and happy and cured?" And he, being an honest man, said, "No, I still would feel sure that a cancer was there." And so we parted amicably with expressions of esteem on both sides. He went on his worrying way, hoping desperately to find some doctor who would agree with him that he had a cancer of the stomach.

Practically always in these cases, if I get a good medical history of the family, I can learn of other members who were either hypochondriacal or were terrible "worry warts," or ac-

USW Union Head Blamed for Inflation

Los Angeles — (U.P.) — Sen. Barry Goldwater (R-Ariz.), has accused the head of the United Steelworker's Union of creating the current inflationary trend by winning "undue wage increases" for his union.

"One man started the latest inflationary spiral, the head of the steelworkers union, when he won undue wage increases," Goldwater said.

Although he did not name USW President David J. McDonald, the Republican senator said he did not believe the union head acted maliciously but thought he was getting the pay hikes for the best interest of the workers.

Goldwater appeared Wednesday at a joint session of the annual convention of the National and Gravel Assn. and National Ready-mixed Concrete association.

Former Daily Worker Editor Has Seizure

Newport, R.I. — (U.P.) — Louis Budenz, 65, former editor of the Communist Daily Worker, suffered a heart seizure Wednesday night after delivering a lecture on the Communist party in America.

Budenz was reported in "satisfactory" condition today and hospital attendants said he "spent a fairly comfortable night."

He was stricken moments after finishing the talk at St. Joseph's Hall here, the fourth in a series of 10 weekly talks sponsored by Providence College.

Dr. Charles Serbst said Budenz was suffering from an ailment similar to that which struck President Eisenhower.

CROSSWORD PUZZLE

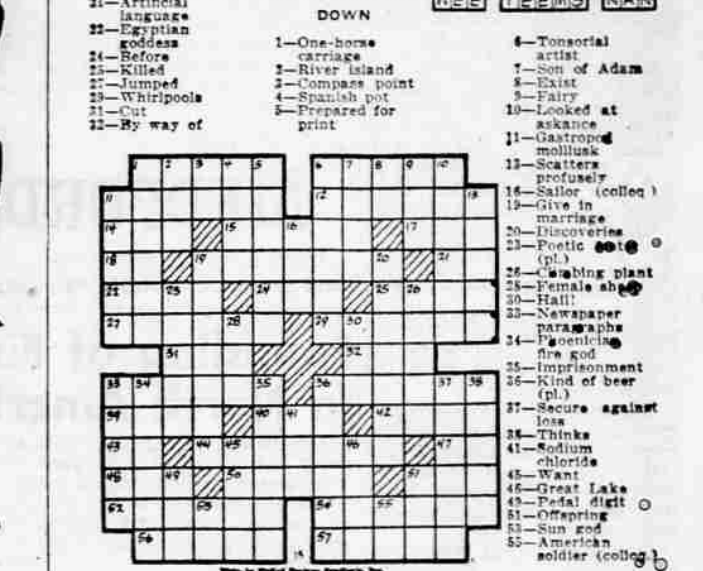
