## Complaint of Dead Dogs Goes to Sheriff

The county court Monday turned over to the sheriff and dog control officer a complaint from a property owner in the Jacksonville area concerning the dumping of about 30 dead dogs on property about two miles south of Jacksonville on the old Jacksonville Hill rd. According to the court, the dogs were apparently left there at various intervals in the past several weeks. Some appeared to have been killed by gun shots or blows on the head, the court stated.

The court has been unable to determine who left the dogs there and no plans have been made for removal of the carcasses.

## No Agreement on 'Key District' Bill

Portland —(U.P.)— Educators from Portland and other parts of the state met here this week to try to work out a compromise on the controversial "key district" school bill but indications were that no agreement was reached. The measure would give state money to schools on a different formula from that now used to distribute basic school support funds.

Portland educators claim they stand to lose \$4 million in state money under the measure if the present \$80 per census child ratio is maintained.

Representing those in favor of the measure included Leonard Mayfield, Medford superintendent.
