**Washington**—The alleged voice of Multnomah County, Ore., District Attorney William M. The victim was identified as Mrs. Bernice Alice McCluskey, 57. Attendants at Corning Memorial hospital said her husband, Clouis Vaughn McCluskey, 55, was not expected to live. Two sons, Michael, 13, and Danny, 9, were also hospitalized with minor injuries.

The highway patrol said the driver of the pickup, Carl E. Starkey, 41, Chico, was struck by the station wagon as he made a left turn in the middle of the road.

# AEC Reveals Blast At Los Alamos Plant

Los Alamos, N. M. — (U.P.) — The Atomic Energy Commission today revealed an explosion during an experiment here Feb. 12 had wrecked a special nuclear reactor, the Godiva.

The AEC said the experiment on the "prompt criticality reactor" was being operated by remote control and no one was injured in the explosion.

An AEC spokesman said damage to the reactor, which had been in use since August, 1951, was so severe that it was declared a total wreck.

The spokesman said that no other damage was done in the building which housed the experiment and radiation contamination was removed by standard methods with no appreciable loss of uranium.

# Letter Contains Checks To Pay Fine

San Francisco — (U.P.) — James Cannon, director of the Traffic Fines Bureau, opened an envelope from Howard Frohlich and took out a \$2 parking tag.

Then he removed a check to Frohlich for 20 cents as a dividend for one share of Pan American stock, a state expense account check to Frohlich for \$1.35 and a check to Frohlich for 40 cents as a refund from a stockbroker. All the checks were endorsed over to the bureau.

However, they totaled only \$1.95. Cannon looked again and found Frohlich's personal check for 5 cents to make up the difference.
