IRRITATION OF THE SKIN BY NICKEL I recently read an interesting article on those many persons who suffer irritation of their skin whenever it comes in prolonged contact with nickel or some alloy of nickel. I am told that nickel is used commonly in jewelry, clasps, clips, buckles, zippers, watches, suspenders, thumbles, needles, metal chairs, coins, cardholder handles, baby carriages, umbrellas, hand-bags and refrigerators.

Beck Given Time To Submit Records

Washington—(U.P.)—The Senate Labor Rackets Committee Saturday gave Teamster Union President Dave Beck until 3 p.m. (EST) Wednesday to agree to surrender his personal financial records or face a subpoena. Chairman John L. McClellan (D-Ark.) agreed to wait until Beck confers in Seattle, Wash., with his attorneys Tuesday. But he said he wants the issue settled. McClellan said that when the committee gets Beck's books and examines them, it will be ready to question the portly president of the nation's biggest union. Beck, who returned six days ago from Europe, asked for a delay when McClellan telegraphed him Friday demanding an almost immediate decision on whether he would turn over his financial records to the special senate committee which has started a nationwide investigation of the teamsters as the first target of a general labor racketeering inquiry.

Wisconsin Twins, 3, Drown in River

Merrill, Wis.—(U.P.)—The Wisconsin river claimed the lives of 3-year-old twin brothers who fell through the ice Sunday and drowned. The victims, Timothy and Thomas Scott, were sons of Mr. and Mrs. George Scott. A search was started soon after they were reported missing from their home in the morning. Their tricycles were discovered near the river, and two holes were in the ice. Firemen recovered the bodies.
