Cataracts in the Eyes Many people ask me what to do about cataracts, and particularly a cataract in one eye. By a cataract we mean an opacity or clouding or frosting of the lens of the eye. We do not know exactly why they come, but diabetics are prone to get them. When both eyes are affected, an ophthalmologist (eye man) will operate as soon as the lenses are hard enough to be pushed out of their capsule. What the doctor does is to make a cut along the upper edge of the cornea (window of the eye). Then he usually makes a cut in the anterior capsule of the lens and through this and the other cut he pushes the lens out. If all goes well, and if the retina or seeing part in the back of the eye is in good shape, the probably be of such different size that my brain would not be able to fuse them into one. I know that a few ophthalmologists like to operate on one solitary cataract, but I can't see the sense in it. Here on my desk is a letter just received from a man who says he is very sorry that he had one cataract removed because formerly he got along perfectly well with his good eye. Now that both eyes can see he can't focus on things, and this interferes with his vision and his sense of balance. It is very embarrassing to him in his business. He has to wear an opaque glass in front of one eye, and he wishes devoutly that he had left things as they were.

Applications for Payments Received

More than 100 applications have been received by the Medford social security office under the recent amendment to the social security law providing for benefit payments to disabled workers 50 years of age or over, according to W. V. Nusbaum, district manager.

This is in addition to 530 applications to "freeze" wage records, received from disabled persons under age 50. "Freeze" applications have been taken since Jan. 1, 1955. However, applications for benefit payments have been accepted only since last October, with payments to start in July.

Applications filed after June 30 can be made retroactive for only one year with the result that workers who have been disabled for some time, and who have not worked since September 1954, will not be able to qualify to have their social security records frozen or to be paid disability insurance benefits at or after age 50.
