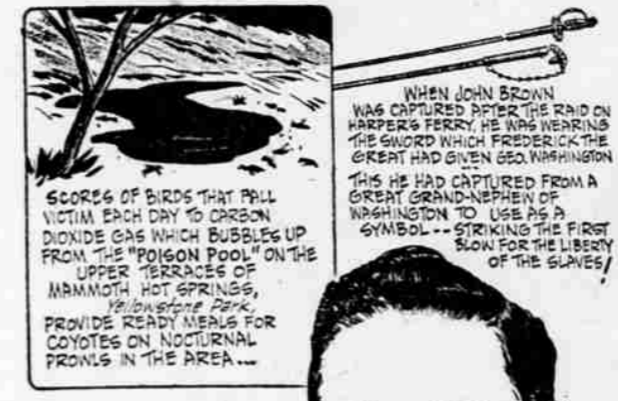

Porphyria There is a rather rare hereditary disease called porphyria which has great importance today because every person with this trouble takes barbiturates — and especially the sodium pentothal that is used as an anesthetic during an operation — is likely to be severely ill. He may even die.

Dr. Alvarez Since these people suffer much from abdominal pain, many get operated on needlessly, and in the process, lose their life. Most of these people are so highly nervous that many are told they are just neurotic.

Planting Being Delayed by Rain Forage crops and cereal crops is considerably delayed by excessive late rain in the Rogue valley, according to W. B. (Ben) Tucker, county agriculture agent.

Tucker said the crops cannot be planted until about 10 days or two weeks after the last heavy rain of the season when the ground has had time to dry out. He explained planting can start sooner in areas where soil is sandy, but heavy soil requires more time to dry.

The county agent predicted Rogue Valley farmers would raise more corn and sudan grass this year than in the past because of inability to get other crops in the ground soon enough. Corn and sudan grass should be planted late in April or in May when the ground is warm and dry.

Concrete Bridges Being Constructed in County County road crews are constructing two concrete bridges over irrigation ditches this week and expect to have them open to traffic in about a month, County Engineer Paul Rynning reported Thursday.

Under construction are bridges across Hopkins lateral on Coker Butte rd., and across the Eagle Point irrigation canal near Cobleigh rd. Wood bridges were previously constructed there and have been removed.
