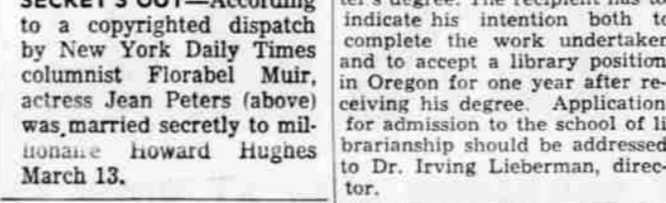

The Marcia M. Hill scholarship to assist a candidate for a master of librarianship degree from the school of librarianship, University of Washington, Seattle, will again be awarded this spring by the Oregon Library association. Application forms may be obtained from the chairman of the committee on scholarship and recruitment, Dr. Jean P. Black, librarian, Portland State college, Portland, and are to be sent to Miss Eleanor Stephens, state librarian, Salem, not later than April 15. The amount of the award this year is \$2000. The successful applicant must have completed four years of college and be accepted by the school of librarianship as a candidate for the master's degree. The recipient has to indicate his intention both to complete the work undertaken and to accept a library position in Oregon for one year after receiving his degree. Application for admission to the school of librarianship should be addressed to Dr. Irving Lieberman, director.
