Symptoms of Diabetes

Many persons ask when they should suspect the presence of diabetes. The symptoms are often extra thirst with the frequent passing of excessive amounts of urine. There often is extra hunger, and perhaps, in spite of eating much, the person loses weight. Rarely the person will notice that when, with his bare feet, he steps on drops of his urine around the toilet bowl, the material is sticky. Occasionally, a diabetic man's wife will complain that his breath has become bad.

Any person who has diabetes in his family should not only be particularly on the watch for signs of diabetes but he will do well to go to an expert internist and ask to be tested to see if he has inherited a tendency to the disease. Especially if he shows signs of this he should have the amount of his blood measured every year. He should make every effort to keep his weight within normal limits because this will lessen his chances of getting diabetes when he is 40.

Small Stroke

One of the commonest diseases of elderly persons is a series of small strokes—strokes which do not produce much if any weakening of muscles, or much if any difficulty with speech. Usually all they produce is a dizzy spell with a temporary loss of the normal good sense of balance, plus perhaps some slowing-up, some loss of memory, some irritability, and some loss of ability to carry on with work. Often the family knows that something has gone wrong with the patient because he or she is not as keen and able and pleasant as he (or she) used to be. The person may complain of a vile taste or a burning in the mouth, or a misery or burning in an area of skin, or ordinary huskiness of speech, or difficulty in swallowing or "rubbery legs," or a sudden loss of much weight.
