Petitions Call for Limiting Tax Rate On Private Homes

Portland—(U.P.)—Petitions calling for a vote on a proposed constitutional amendment seeking to limit the tax rate on private homes are being circulated in Oregon, according to a co-sponsor of the proposal.

Lew Wallace, who has long been active in Democratic affairs, said he circulated petition No. 1 this week and had no refusals from 100 persons he asked to sign. He said another 124 such petitions were circulating in Oregon.

Backers have until July of 1958 to obtain 48,163 signatures. Wallace predicted the required number will be obtained "at least by Christmas and maybe in 90 days."

Tax on Homesteads
The proposal "provides that dwellings which are homesteads shall not be taxed at a rate greater than 50 per cent of the tax rate applicable to land which has no buildings, improvements or timber thereon, or 50 per cent of the tax rate applicable to ordinary buildings which are not homesteads, whichever is less."

Homesteads are defined as being limited to a building or structure exclusive of land which is the actual abode of an occupied by the owner, husband or wife, parent or child.

Two County Library Stations Close

The Jackson county library stations in the Applegate area and at Shady Cove have been closed this week until further notice.

Altered circumstances make it impossible for Mrs. Gail Buffington, who has operated the station during the past several months, to continue it in her residence on the Upper Applegate road, according to Miss Helen Webster, librarian.

If suitable quarters and supervision can be found elsewhere in the area for the station, another agency will be set up at some later date, she said.

The space donated during the winter months by Mr. and Mrs. Carroll Watson of the "Treasure Trove" is needed for other purposes during the summer season, Miss Webster reported. Books are available from the Jackson county library for a library agency at Shady Cove if other quarters can be provided.

Residents who provide housing and care for library stations do so on a purely voluntary basis, acting from an interest in good reading and a desire to be of service to their communities.

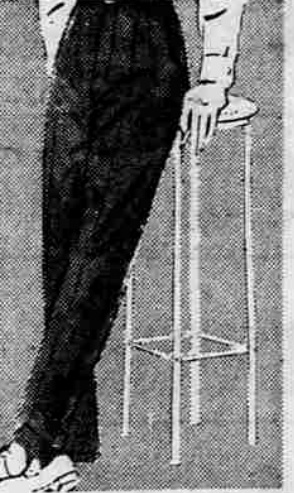
