District Judge Frank McNamee granted the divorce at a closed hearing. He ordered the actor to pay \$100 monthly support for the couple's only child, Kerry, 14, and also approved a property settlement which was reached last Feb. 7.

Miss Blair and Kelly were married in Philadelphia Sept. 22, 1941. They separated for the final time two months ago.
