Here's what to watch for and do so your youngster won't be handicapped by defective eyesight.



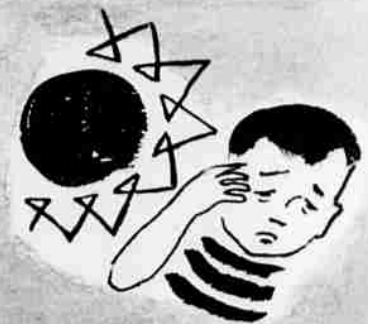
Eye care may be needed if your child rubs his eyes.

Abnormal sensitivity to light can be danger sign.

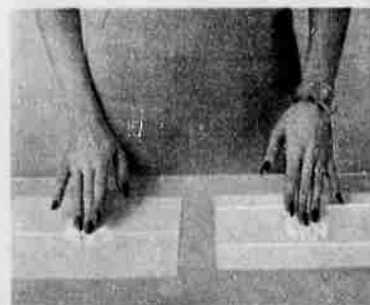

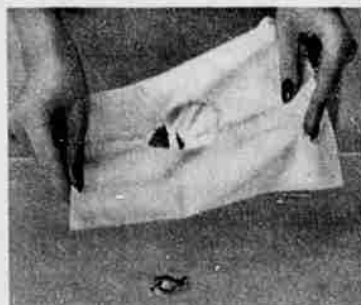

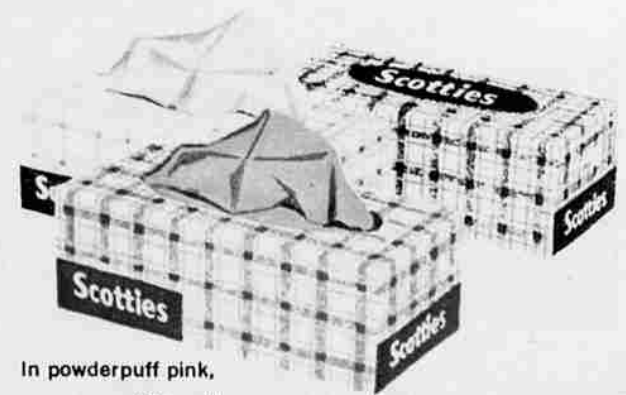
