The Medical Roundup

A New Medicine for Diabetes

Ever since 1921, when insulin was discovered, doctors and patients have wished that some similar drug could be found that would work when given by mouth. Some physicians worked for years trying to find some way of giving insulin by mouth, but never succeeded; the substance was digested in the stomach and made inert. Recently, it was found that a certain sulfa drug (tolbutamide) will lower blood sugar when given by mouth, and recently in New York City, 1100 experts met for a two-day conference on the subject, sponsored by the New York Academy of Sciences. The drug worked well in from 50 to 75 per cent of cases. It works best for persons more than 40 years of age with a mild form of diabetes. In cases of children and young persons with a severe form of diabetes it is hardly worth trying. It will help perhaps one in three persons between the ages of 20 and 40 years of age, who have a mild form of the disease. In many cases now a patient finds he can shift over from insulin to the new drug.

Dr. Henry Dolger of New York reported that he had seen no bad side reactions. Dr. Alexander Marble of the Joslin Clinic in Boston reported 66 per cent success in treating more than 400 patients. In all, some 1500 patients with diabetes have now been treated.

Depends on Cells

According to Dr. Loubatieres, of Montpellier, France, a favorable response to the new drug seems to depend on the amount of insulin-producing cells left in the pancreas. For this reason, a child with a severe diabetes and practically no insulin production, cannot be helped by the new drug.

A point that I wish to emphasize is that this new drug has been brought forward and developed by one of America's great drug houses, presided over by laymen. Every year I receive a number of unpleasant and accusing letters from friends of cancer quacks who assure me that we in the medical profession are so selfish and narrow-minded that when a cure for cancer is discovered by a quack or other layman we refuse to use it. I hope these people will note now that when some chemist who never practiced medicine came forward with a new drug that looked promising, within a year it had been tried out eagerly by able physicians in every civilized part of the globe. No one cared a hoot where the drug had come from or who had found it; all the doctors wanted to know was, would it work, was it safe, and where could they get some of it. Every doctor is so happy when he can bring help to his patients that he will try anything that looks promising and safe.

Around Hollywood

Hollywood—(U.P.)—Red Buttons, a short-lived sensation on television, is rising from the ashes as a changed character. He now is a dramatic actor in the movies. Little George Gobel of TV back in 1953, in the dear, old days of straight windshields and Italian haircuts.

But, as TV victims know, fans are as fickle as the flick of a dial, and the hungry medium can burn up a career that in movies or radio might have lasted a decade. After three years and 34 writers, Red was sent to the showers.

Now he's begun a new career that may turn out bigger than the old. Red copped a plum role, star billing in a Marlon Brando picture, "Sayonara."

Role Promising

Director Josh Logan thinks Red's role may do for him what "From Here to Eternity" did to a then-slipping singer, Frank Sinatra.

"I'm awfully young to be having a comeback," the 32-year-old comedian grinned. "I couldn't be happier—I have the best part of my career ahead of me. This is a straight dramatic part, not one gag."

"Of course," he added wryly, "some of my comedy shows turned out that way."

In his TV days Red was famed for hiring small armies of writers and firing them two weeks later. As he says, "I opened a Chinese fortune cookie when we were on location in Japan for 'Sayonara' and it said, 'Help me, I'm a writer for Red Buttons.'"

Firings Explained

"I hired a lot of writers because I was trying to get a good show," he explained.

Red reflected on his slide out of TV and said, "the trouble starts when you realize during the second year how good you were the first year. The first year you're numb. You lose perspective. You look through very rose-colored glasses.

UAW May Seek Work Week With Four Days
Atlantic City, N.J.—(U.P.)—United Auto Workers Chief Walter Reuther disclosed Saturday that the union would demand a four-day work week in contract negotiations next year.

Reuther said the union membership was overwhelmingly in favor of a "shorter week—not a shorter day."

The UAW president also said at a news conference preceding the opening today of the union's 16th convention that the auto industry would be asked for higher take-home pay. He did not specify how much.
