

Portland Teamsters Vote To Deny Funds, Censure Officials

Portland —(U.P.)— The largest Teamster local in Oregon Thursday night voted unanimously to deny union funds to the support of any union official accused of dipping into union treasuries. Members of Local 162, some 1500 of them, also unanimously voted censure of leaders of the International Brotherhood of Teamsters and the Western Conference of the union. Members said after the meeting in civic auditorium that the name of General President Dave Beck was mentioned in censuring speeches. **Closed to Newsmen** Newsmen were not admitted to the meeting which was postponed from last week when Teamster Hall was found too

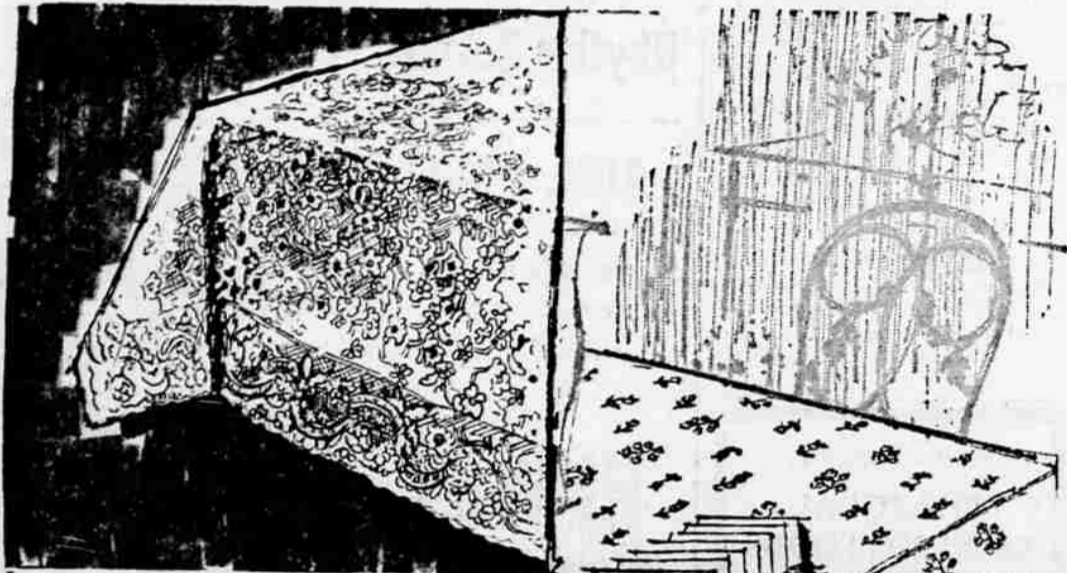
small to accommodate the unusual turnout. Officers said after Thursday night's meeting that the gathering was orderly and there was no need for the seven off-duty policemen hired to maintain order. Reporters found an effigy of Beck lying outside the auditorium by a side door. The dummy bore a sign reading, "It's later than you think." Members also voted to exonerate member Harry Federspiel who was recently called on the carpet by Oregon Teamster leaders for statements with his petition commending the Senate Labor Rackets Committee for its probe of Teamster affairs. give the executive board full power to act against Federspiel, Boos and Catcalls. Members said there were a few boos and catcalls when it was announced that Oregon Teamster Chief Clyde Crosby could not attend the meeting because of another meeting in Los Angeles. They said there appeared to be general satisfaction with officers of the local and criticism was mainly directed against international officers.
