The Medical Roundup

Hemophilia, or Severe Bleeding
One of the most distressing of the inherited diseases of man is hemophilia or a tendency to bleed terribly. Because this disease is rare, and most physicians are not prepared to deal with it skillfully, all persons who know that they have this inherited trouble or tendency should get in touch with the nearest chapter of the Hemophilia Foundation of which there are 17 in the United States. There are now dozen good-sized clinics where people with the disease can be well treated. One of the largest is at Mt. Sinai Hospital, in New York City; another is the Marquette School of Medicine, in Milwaukee, and another is at the Mayo Clinic, in Rochester, Minn. The Cutter Laboratories in Berkeley, Calif., are now preparing a constituent of blood plasma which helps blood-clotting in patients with this disease. No person with hemophilia should ever have a tooth extracted or an operation performed without first getting expert

Because so many people think that socialized medicine will be the answer to all their troubles with doctors, I like to read what state medicine is working in other countries. I was just reading an article by a physician who has recently returned from Russia, where he saw a good deal of their medicine. He thought the doctors he saw were poorly trained. They lacked enthusiasm, partly because their equipment was so poor and so primitive, partly because many of their methods of treatment were so backward, and partly because the pay was so inadequate. A village doctor starts on less than \$125 a month. A workman in a factory gets between \$150 and \$200 a month. More than half the doctors are women. Nearly all the obstetrical work is done by midwives. Anesthesia is not given to the mothers.

A sanatorium treating from 300 to 400 patients a month will have an old-fashioned and outmoded x-ray machine which was made in America or Germany years ago. (Released by The Register and Tribune Syndicate, 1957)
