

Navy Men Arrested On Auto Theft Charge

Santa Rosa, Calif. —(U.P.)—Two Navy enlisted men were held today on federal auto theft charges.

The Federal Bureau of Identification in San Francisco identified them as Paul Earl Richardson, 18, of Wallace, Idaho, and Wilfred George Smart, 21, of Cleveland, Ohio.

The FBI said they were taken into custody in Santa Rosa Wednesday night and charged with driving a stolen car from Reno, Nev., to Santa Rosa.

The FBI said they went AWOL from the USS Boxer when it was stationed in San Diego last February.

Chrysler Walkout Halts Production

Detroit —(U.P.)—A walkout at the Chrysler Kercheval plant has halted car production and idled 4,000 workers.

Chrysler sent home 60 men who normally handle material shipped to a strikebound Los Angeles plant. Another 240 workers in the material handling department walked out in protest and the company then sent home the remaining 8,100 hourly workers at the plant.

Meetings were held between United Auto Workers officials and Chrysler management in an effort to settle the dispute.

Electrocuted Man Left on High Pole

San Antonio, Tex. —(U.P.)—A lineman was electrocuted Wednesday while working on a 40 foot pole and was not removed from the scene by police, who said the lineman's employer, City Public Service Co., asked he be left until a company doctor arrived.

The lineman, Edwin Peters, was pronounced dead by the company doctor, who arrived 59 minutes later.

It was not determined whether emergency treatment might have saved him. Firemen administered oxygen while the police stood by.

Police Chief George Bichsel said the "line supervisor insisted that the lineman remain at the scene. I couldn't pass or whether the man was alive or not but he seemed warm."

He said the company has a policy "for anyone electrocuted or hurt while on the job to remain at the scene until a company doctor can get there."

Missing University Space Rocket Found

Washington —(U.P.)—The University of Maryland has found its missing 3,800-mile-an-hour space rocket.

Moreover, campus police who spent all day Thursday looking for the 15-foot long "Terrapin" and campus jokers suspect it didn't get to the four-story high roof on its own power.

The 200-pound rocket—lent to the university by Republic Aviation Corp.—had been on display in the Student Union building.

When officials opened up the building Thursday morning, the rocket was gone. A note lying in its place said:
