## Locations, Programs, And Music Announced

**Earliest Service Scheduled in East**  
Ringe, N. H.—(U.P.)—The "Cathedral of the Pines" will be the scene of the earliest sunrise service in the country Easter Sunday.

The non-denominational service will begin at 4:45 a.m. (EST) and will conclude when the first rays of the sun are visible shortly after 5 a.m. More than 5,000 persons from many parts of the nation are expected to be on hand for the 12th annual Easter service.

This unique shrine, soon to be designated a national war memorial by act of Congress, was founded in 1946 and "dedicated to the glory of God and in loving and grateful memory of Sander Sloan by his parents, Douglas and Sybil Sloan." Sandy Sloan, a World War II pilot, was killed on a mission over Germany.

Since 1946 more than two million persons have visited the pine-bordered sanctuary with its sweeping view of mountain, forest and lake.
