The Medical Roundup

A New Drug for Pinworms It is estimated that pinworms infest some 16,000,000 persons in the United States. In the past, there has been no good remedy with which to kill them off. A while ago, Drs. H. W. Brown, Kam-Fai Chan, and K. A. H. Lee, of the University of Columbia, reported that, today, with the drug piperazine citrate (which is obtainable in drug stores in the form of a syrup or wafers, either of which is acceptable to children) in 58 of 60 cases the patient was cured in a week. It was found important to give one large dose a day for a week. The medicine also is very good for the killing off of round worms. In any treatment of pinworms it is well to combat the reinfestation of members of the family by having the child wear at night a snug pair of panties. These have to be boiled every day to kill the eggs. During the night the mother worms come out on the skin of the buttocks and lay their eggs. If care is not taken, eggs will get into a child's food by way of his finger nails or through the air, and then the cycle of growth of the worms will begin all over again. All the members of a family who are infested with the worms should be treated at the same time. Otherwise, reinfestation is likely to take place. A Center for Blood Studies In the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, there is a remarkable "Serum Exchange" which, since its founding in 1934, has specialized in helping doctors with problems connected with blood diseases. One of the troubles that is combated is due to the RH factor of mothers. Dr. Neva Abelson, Director of the Exchange, said recently that the well-known A and B factors in blood are just as likely to cause trouble as is the RH factor. Today, by testing a newborn infant's blood with a special spectrophotometer, experts can tell how an RH baby has to be treated. In about a third of the cases the child will not need any transfusion; in another third, he will need one transfusion; and in another third he will need more than one transfusion. In the Exchange, Drs. Joseph Stokes Jr. and Joseph Smolens have perfected a method of withdrawing blood from a donor, taking the cells from the plasma (liquid of the blood) and putting them back into the donor. With this method a donor can give blood as often as once a week. The body can replace the plasma overnight, but it takes time to build new red cells.

Daniels' daughter, Debra Lorie, received minor bruises in the accident, according to officers. She was taken by police to Sacred Heart hospital, where she was examined by physicians and released. It was reported. The car struck by the Daniels vehicle in the intersection was operated by Bill Faye Walker, 1701 East Main st.
