Psychiatric Treatment by Night

Since 1954, the Montreal General hospital has had a "night-center" where they have treated more than 200 mentally troubled patients. Most of these persons could not afford to stop their work, as they had to earn a living. Now they come to the hospital about 6 p.m.; they spend the night, and they leave at 8 in the morning. They do not get the social stigma of having been in mental hospital.

The patients are helped by psychotherapy, insulin shock, electroshock, or occupational, recreational, group or social types of treatment. The average duration of the course was, for women, 28 days, and for men, 21 days. The treatment usually starts with insulin, which tends to remove anxieties.

Around Hollywood

Hollywood—U.P.—The legend of the late James Dean, according to a couple of tourists in Hollywood, has been exaggerated and at times just isn't true.

The visitors, Mr. and Mrs. Marcus Winslow, of Fairmont, Ind., spoke as they began a tour of Warner Studio, un-

noticed by the other out-of-towners inspecting the film factory.

To the quiet, reserved Winslows it was a special trip, for they were seeing for the first time the working place of Dean, the boy they brought up in Indiana after his mother died and his father moved to California.

"Oh, the things we've heard about Jimmy," said Winslow, shaking his head. "One story said the headstone on his grave had been chipped. Not a word of truth in it."

"The headstone is just as nice as when it was new. A very high class of people visit his grave. Around Jim's grave is a path four feet wide, and you know how high the grass grows in Indiana!"

"They keep saying Jimmy was 'rebellious,' put in his wife, Hortense. 'Jimmy actually was the type who just goes out and does things himself. I've never known anybody so determined. 'He had no pull, no money, he worked for everything himself.'"

One account of Dean's life the Winslows call authentic, however, is a documentary movie, "The James Dean Story," which will be released soon. They attended a preview of the picture.
