Is Overwork Causing Heart Attacks?

Nowadays, one keeps reading that the strain of business is killing off overworked executives; it is giving them heart attacks. But I am not sure this is true. In order to get light on the matter, I turned to the valuable Statistical Bulletin of the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company. There I see that last year in the age group 45 to 54 2.2 men died to 1 woman. In the age group 55 to 64, when business burdens are usually great the ratio was 2.1 to 1.

At first glance this doubling of the mortality of men as compared with that of women is impressive, but we must not jump to the conclusion that it is due to business strain. Why? Because among youngsters, between the ages of 15 and 19, we find that 2.5 boys died to 1 girl. In the age 20 to 24 the ratio was 2.6 to 1. Certainly, the boys and young men were not yet worrying terribly about business.

Mayors Surrounded With Civic Problems

Chicago (U.P.)—Affiliations between American cities and "sister cities" abroad are giving mayor's duties an international flavor, the American Municipal Association reports.

The association said nearly a dozen American cities now have informal affiliations with cities overseas in which their citizens feel they have something in common.

Individual citizens have started the movement in each case, the association said, but mayors, other city officials, clubs and students later have participated.

The approach is personal rather than political, and the chief aim is to promote cultural and informational exchanges between the communities.

The association said cities which have formed the friendship exchanges include: Hagerstown, Md., and Wesel, Germany; Portland, N.Y., and Pashawar, Pakistan; Montclair, N.J., and Graz, Austria; Columbus, Ohio, and Genoa, Italy; Detroit, Mich., and Rotterdam, Holland; Kansas City, Mo., and Sao Paulo, Brazil; Savannah, Ga., and Guatemala City, Guatemala; Louisville, Ky., and Montpellier, France.
