

Senate Approves Highway Study By Interim Group

Salem —UP— The Oregon Senate has passed Senate Joint Resolution 36 providing for an interim committee on highway study.

Sen. Harry D. Boivin, Klamath Falls Democrat said the interim committee would study Oregon's plans for highway construction under the federal highway system program expected to bring some \$337 million of federal money into Oregon in the next 10 years.

To Study Weight-Mile Tax

Also to be studied is the impact of the weight-mile tax on the economy of the motor carrier industry in Oregon. Sen. Boivin said the weight-mile tax

had produced more revenue than anticipated and a study would be made of the feasibility of making some adjustment.

Senate bill 62, dealing with the Unemployment Compensation Commission, was sent back to committee again with instructions to provide that members of the commission, after appointment by the governor, be approved by the Senate.

Would Separate Commission

The measure originally called for creation of a one-man employment security commissioner to replace the three-man unemployment Compensation Commission. The bill was sent back once before with instructions to

keep it as a three-man commission and retain the title of unemployment compensation commission. Chief purpose of SB62 now would be to separate the unemployment compensation commission from the State Industrial Accident Commission. At present, the same three members serve on both commissions.
