Contributions to Heart Fund Increase

Memorial contributions to the Oregon Heart association for a nine-month period through March 31 totaled \$16,712 as compared to \$14,786 for the same period a year ago, according to Mrs. Marina Gates of Medford, local memorial chairman.

Jackson county residents contributed a total of \$458.15 from July 1, 1956, to March 31, 1957. During the first quarter of 1956 they contributed \$179.50 as compared to \$214 in the first quarter of 1957.

Mrs. Gates explained that all memorial contributions are earmarked for heart research. Memorial contributions are made in the name of individuals who have died from heart diseases. The Oregon Heart association will spend approximately \$50,000 for research at Oregon institutions this year, Mrs. Gates said. Projects are under way at the University of Oregon medical school, Oregon State college, University of Portland and Reed college.
