Missionary Uses Ship In Parish of Islands
Boston—U.P.—More than a century ago Boston school children dived their pennies and bought a ship for use by missionaries among the islands of the Pacific. That vessel was christened Morning Star I.

Now, the American Board of Foreign Missions (Congregational) has raised \$17,000 in the United States to buy Morning Star VII, which will serve as a floating church for the Rev. Eleanor Wilson of Cambridge, a 65-year-old missionary who has spent 16 years in the Carolina and Marshall islands. This will replace Morning Star VI, which sank in 1952.
Miss Wilson's parish includes 1,000 islands.
